Super Global Course Kyoto University School of Public Health 2018

In concordance with Kyoto University's educational reform policy, under the Top Global University Project, aiming to produce a new generation of world-leading researchers through a synergy of internationalization strategies involving both education and research and in effort to put forth high standards and strengthen public health education, training and research to improve the quality of the public health workforce in Japan and globally, Kyoto University School of Public Health (KUSPH) encourages its students to pursue international experience through building alliances with renowned public/global health related educational intuitions for research collaboration (i.e. thesis joint-supervision), student's leadership and active involvement of the School's annual international conference and students' workshop during "The 2018 Kyoto Global Conference for Rising Public Health Researchers", and interactive participation in the "Global Health" course that intends to provide students with introductory understanding of the most critical issues in global health.

The 3 main requisites for the SGC-KUSPH are as follow:-

① Research Joint Supervision

The student's research project (leading to the thesis at KUSPH) should be jointly supervised by the main supervisor at KUSPH and co-supervisor(s) from other overseas universities. Official partners are as listed and may be given priority:-

- Chiang Mai University Faculty of Public Health
- Chulalongkorn University College of Public Health Science
- London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine
- Mahidol University Faculty of Public Health
- National Taiwan University College of Public Health
- National University of Singapore Saw Swee Hock School of Public Health
- University of Malaya Faculty of Medicine, Department of Social & Preventive Medicine
- · Or any other overseas universities of choice

Under this requirement, the student is eligible to apply for a travel scholarship to visit co-supervisor(s) for the purpose of research. The <u>required documents *</u> for scholarship application are as listed:-

- One page proposal of your research to tell us why you should receive this scholarship. The
 evaluation of your application is heavily based on this document
- A written informed consent from main supervisor at KUSPH
- Proof of research communications (preferable emails) with co-supervisor(s)

- Letter of co-supervision agreement. This letter from the co-supervisor(s) must:
 - o be written on the official letterhead of the co-supervisor(s)' organisation;
 - be signed by the co-supervisor(s);
 - o describe the role and tasks of the co-supervisor(s) during the research
- Letter of invitation from co-supervisor(s) specifying the travel dates
- Travel itinerary and activity plan during the visit
- Travel insurance during the period of visit (to be submitted after the results announcement, before traveling)

The scholarship will cover

- Roundtrip air-ticket from Kansai International Airport to the closest airport to the partner university
- Daily allowance and accommodation expenses for a maximum of 6 days (rates depending on the country of visit in compliance with the regulations of Kyoto University). The students who wish to stay longer are responsible for their own expenses after the 6-day period
- Travel insurance
- Visa application fees (if any)
- ② Enroll and pass the evaluation of the "Global Health" course (course code Z203) at KUSPH
- ③ Fully take part in "The 2018 Kyoto Global Conference for Rising Public Health Researchers" (December 3-4, 2018):-
- Students Conference Organizing Committee
- Poster or Oral presentation of ongoing research or research protocol

The student will be awarded with the SGC's recognition from the President of Kyoto University when completing his/her master's or doctoral degree at KUSPH regardless of year of enrollment in the SGC
