She participated in two short courses at University of Oslo, Norway for International Community Health and Optimal Allocation and Economic Evaluation for Health Resources and Health Technologies. She received the 2011 Outstanding Royal Golden Jubilee Alumni Awards, the Exemplary Researcher Award of Prince of Songkla University 2012, and the Exemplary Award for Academic Services of Faculty of Medicine 2017. Regarding her research capacity, her publication in *Int. J. Gynecol. Obstet.* received an Honorable Mention in the John J. Sciarra IJGO Prize Paper Award for 2017.

She has served as the international consultant on maternal and reproductive health, health care reform, evidence-based medicine, surveillance system on maternal-newborn health, proposal development and data analysis.
